This year we have added a U-16 Division and were able to secure the use of the Sportsplex in Feasterville, PA for the earlier half of the competition schedule. The Sportsplex in Feasterville has recently upgraded their three Indoor Courts with the recent acquisition of International quality, German style sideboards. The 422 Sportsplex in Pottstown, PA has also been secured to return as host of the latter half of the schedule.
