A) BEFORE DEPARTURE

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: Your team is composed with players who are still considered minor, so we would like to remind that before players departure parents or legal guardians must sign Form Code of Conduct (to be presented at the Technical Meetings before the tournament starts), and any other Travel Permits required by the laws and regulations in your country.

ATTENTION: According Regulation # 4.2b (see link below), players are required to submit PASSPORT as proof of identity, nationality and age - all teams. If a player has dual nationality, for purposes of the tournament, he will have to show the passport of the country represented in the competition for passports check. [even if player is traveling with another passport due to visa issues]. We remind that all delegations (Team Managers) must bring passports of the players to check with the Entry Forms at the technical meeting.

B) LOCAL TRANSPORT

1 – As the Organizing Committee is planning transport to and from the airport, we kindly request participant teams to inform all *travel details* (flights of arrival and departure) and *confirmation of Hotel* where your team will be staying. Please do so directly to the staff of the Organizing Committee **by**







January 27, 2014 (18 hours of Puerto Rico). Please locate tournament staff upon arrival (look for signs with the tournament logo).

2 – **Transport for Practices/Training**: Transport for practices/training (Practice-Hotel-Practice) will be provided on the 02nd and 3rd of February, 2014. For teams training before those dates, the organization may make arrangements, but teams are responsible for the costs of the transportation to and from the stadium.

3 – *Transport to matches*: Teams will be required to arrive to the stadium 45 minutes before game time. Departure times of the hotels will be confirmed on arrival of the teams to San Juan. Team Managers are required to communicate with the Local Organization for ground transportation arrangements.

C) MATCHES & TRAININGS

The Venue for both Tournament and Traiings wil be: **Stadium Roberto Gotay** Urb. **Baldrich Avenue Domenech**, Hato Rey, San Juan – Puerto Rico

Some training requests were sent to the Tournament Director, Javier Zanini (<u>arqjpz@gmail.com</u>) and to the Competition Coordinator, Julio F Neves (<u>julio.neves@panamhockey.org</u>), responsible for the official schedule of tournament practices. The same will be sent shortly. (Bulletin#2)

According to the possibilities of meeting countries requests, to ensure that all teams have, at least 2 training sessions of 1h hour in the field of competition before the tournament starts, and to guarantee equity in the distribution of the number of hours of practice during the tournament, an official training spreadsheet will be prepared. Please send your requests, with preferred time to practice, to Cedric Sasso **before January 26, 2014**.

D) MEALS

The choice and arrangement of meals will be responsibility of the teams (Team Managers). Meals at hotels should be coordinated by the Team Managers with their respective hotels. There are many dining options around the tournament hotels.

E) TOURNAMENT BRIEFING MEETINGS

It is **MANDATORY FOR ALL** teams to attend the Tournament Briefing Meetings by sending a maximum of 2 representatives per team (one must be the Team Manager).

ATTENTION: The following will be required to present to the Tournament Director at the meeting:







Final Team Entry Forms;

2. Acknowledgement Forms of the Code of Conduct* completed and signed by ALL team members as named at Team Entry Form;

3. Player's passports for check and confirmation of identity, nationality and age (only passports will accepted according Regulations);

Uniforms sets (distinct colors between Primary and Alternate sets);

5. Goalkeeper equipment and players gloves.

F) RULES & REGULATIONS

The FIH Hockey5s Rules dated 01 of Septiembre 2012 will be in effect for this tournament.

Current FIH Hockey5s Regulations dated December 2013 will be applied.

Since the Hockey5s format is still in its infancy, there are some inconsistencies between the Regulations and Rules, which were already detected and were sent to the FIH for clarification. Same thing about the sideboards and backboards. As soon as we have concrete resolutions, we will inform (Bulletin # 2). Meanwhile, do not hesitate to send us any inquiry or question.

G) ACREDITATION

You are required to send 2x2 pictures of each member of your delegation (JPG format, name file with name of respective delegation member) to the Organizing Committee – responsable: Katherine Santiago, kapsantiago@gmail.com.

H) MEDICAL

Team Managers are required to inform PAHF and the Organizing Committee, before January 30th, 2014, which hospitals are allowed by your team's health insurance for use in San Juan, if needed. There are two hospitals very near the stadium (less than 5 minutes) in case of emergency. Team insurance is being offered by the Organizing Committee (US\$250).
