Geography

If you didn't know already, Guyana is located on the North East Coast of South America; it is the fourth smallest country after French Guiana, Suriname and Uruguay.

Did You Know: Guyana is also the only English speaking country in South America?

Though the official language is English, it is often spoken with a Caribbean Creole Flavor so if you hear someone saying "weh side you from" it simply means "which country are you from". Not to worry you will get accustomed to our style of communicating.

Time Zone: GMT - 04:00: One hour ahead of EST.


Population: Guyana's Population is approximately 746,955 (Census 2012) of whom 90% live along the coastal strip and banks of major rivers. We are small but very hospitable.

This is amazing: Guyana's diaspora is made up of six races: Europeans, Amerindians, Africans, East Indians, Portuguese and Chinese.

Climate

Guyana is a tropical destination moderated by the northeast trade winds; the climate is pleasant and warm for most of the year.

With mean temperature of 27oC and the average temperature range from 24oC to 31oC, lightweight casual clothing is always in style. But we are not all sunshine, grab your umbrellas and rain boots when our two rainy seasons starts (May to June, November to January).

What you need to know



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All visitors to Guyana are required to have a valid passport to enter and depart Guyana. Your passport should have at least six months of remaining validity. Those arriving by air require an onward plane ticket.

Traveling around Georgetown

Georgetown has many architectural designs as different as the six races living in it; a true testimony that there is beauty in diversity. But before you get to these places you need to know HOW to get to these places.

How much do I pay? Taxi fare from Airport to Georgetown range between US\$25.00 and US\$30.00. Traffic drives on the left. Make sure you buckle up, seat belts are necessary by Law.



Traveling by Taxi for short distances: Approximately GY\$300 – GY\$400; longer drops of GY\$500 and more as these prices vary from location. Rented cars are also available.

Travelling around Georgetown by Bus: Short stops within the limits of the city are approximately GY\$80 and longer stops GY\$100.

Money & Business Guide

ATM machines are accessible to persons with ATM Debit cards. Persons in possession of international CIRRUS credit cards that are Master Cards and Visa Cards may utilize the ATMs at Scotia Bank for cash advances when in Guyana.

Currency

The rate of the dollar fluctuates and the exchange is approximately US\$1-GY\$225. Major credit cards and traveler's cheques are generally accepted at many resorts, hotels, gift shops, restaurants and tour operators.

Sight Seeing

We know you've got one thing on your mind and that's winning the Indoor Pan-American Cup. And we also know how important it is to take a break from all of that practice. That's why we've put together this little guide for you. Of course there is much more to see and do but that warrants a second trip.

The Castellani House



The Castellani House is a large nineteenth-century building, which is situated on the corner of Vlissengen Road and Homestretch Avenue in Georgetown, Guyana. It was designed and constructed by the Maltese architect, Cesar Castellani, between 1879 and 1882. Originally serving as a residence for colonial government officials, Castellani House has been the home of Guyana's National Art Gallery since 1993.

St. George's Cathedral



St. George's Cathedral is an Anglican cathedral and is one of the tallest wooden churches in the world, at a height of 43.5 meters (143 ft.). It is located on Church Street in Georgetown, and has been designated a National Monument. The interior of the church makes for fascinating history. Whether it is an article of furniture, the chalices, the memorial tablets or the Baptism registers - they all tell a story. The story is not only about Guyana's history, but glimpses of its Caribbean neighbours are also revealed.

Botanical Gardens



The Botanical

Gardens was established in 1878. The garden is laid out on 185 acres of land plantation Vlissengen (an abandon sugar estate).

Promenade Gardens



The Promenade

Gardens is located on what was once a field known as Parade Ground, originally the entire area was used for military parades and training.

The National Park



This park is utilized for

cultural, educational and recreational activities. The National Park, formerly occupied by the Demerara Golf Club since 1923 was renamed the Queen Elizabeth II National Park in 1965 in honor of the Queen's visit to Guyana. On Guyana's attainment of independence it became known as the National Park.



If a picture could tell a thousand words, could you imagine what these architectural landmarks might say? Each of these national treasures tells a different story again re-enforcing our diversity. But any trip to Guyana wouldn't be completed without a trip to our Majestic Kaieteur Falls!


