## **Explanatory Notes**

Per diem

- 1. PAHF Rep: EB agreed in 2018 that Rep will no longer be appointed in future events. This decision may be reviewed.
- 2. Pan Am Cup: This event is not normally a joint event due to the large hosting fee. 2 TD's or 1 TD & 1 ATD may be appointed.

Paid for by Host OC

- 3. ATD: This is optional. It can be used as an opportunity for development with specific Tier 1 joint events where there is 1 TD.
- 4. MO: Local Medical Officer can be used. One PAHF doctor for the tournament.
- 5. Media: Use more local personnel for coverage. The host is responsible for providing full board.
- 6. AHF Umpire exchange: look to expand program with Europe for technical officials and umpires.
- 7. \*South American Championship every 4 years as the ODESUR and MultiGames criteria apply
- 8.\*\*PAHF Event: Airfare, meals & accommodation / Per Diem for TD, UM, Neutral umpires and AHF / AfHF Exchange officials are paid for by the OC if only 1 neutral umpire per gender is appointed.

Paid for by Host OC

If 2 neutral umpires are appointed along with AHF / AfHF umpires, airfare for the additional umpire is paid for by AHF / AfHF

Doctor and 1 Media Official per gender are paid for by the OC.

The Event Coordinator expenses paid for by PAHF

9. \*\*\*For Multisport Events: Airfare, accomodations, meals and per diem for neutral umpires and AHF / AfHF exchange officials are paid by OC if only 1 neutral per gender (umpire & TO) is appointed.

If 2 neutral umpires are appointed with umpires from AHF / AfHF Exchange,: Tickets are by AHF / AfHF or PAHF.

Medical - 1 (PAHF pays for the second doctor if 2 are appointed)

Event Coordinator and 1 Communication Officier per gender are paid for by Host OC. Any extra Communication Officers paid for by PAHF.

10. If PAHF hosts any Umpire, Coach or Technical courses:

The host is responsible for the accomodations and meals cost for the facilitators.

PAHF is responsible for the airfare and honorarium for the facilitators.

- 11. The number of teams for Tier 2 events are unlimited, as these events are usually qualifiers for Tier I events.
- 12. At Tier 2 events for two (2) UMs are appointed of which one of the UMs will in a training capacity
- 13. For the Pan AM Youth Championships, which is a hockey 5 event, the number of officials will be reviewed pending the number of teams registered
- 14. For the Tier 2 events, if there is an increase in the number of participating teams, then the increase in number of technical officials will be considered to to ensure adequate coverage for the event.
- 15. If either the AHF or AfHF is unable to appoint umpire(s) that is / are appropriate for the level of the tournament, the FIH will be advised to appoint two neutral umpires capable of officiating at the level of the event
- 16. If either the AHF or AfHF is unable to appoint technical official(s) that is / are appropriate for the level of the tournament, the PAHF Appointments Committee can, at its discretion,

appoint a PAHF technical official capable of officiating at the level of the event

17. The AHF / AfHF Exchange Programme can invoked for either Tier 1 or Tier 2 Events, at the discretion of the PAHF Appointments Committee

Event

If a "Joint or Single" event noted above is hosted as a single event then 1/2 the number of Technical Officials (i.e. TO's & Umpires) applies.

**Building Capacity** 

## The use of "Officials from the Host" is an option available to the Appointments Committee in appointing officials. It is not an obligation under the Chart of Responsibility

With more emphasis being placed on host nations to provide resources for medical and communication, templates and protocols for standard best practices are to be developed, so that the selected national officials are aware of the guidelines of their posts.

For the local Communication Officer, generic assets or toolkits are to be developed as guidelines for them. Some possible training component should also be developed for these potential communication personnel, so that the pool can widen

Hosting

Mandatory joint events: Pan Am Games, Indoor Pan Am Cup, South American Championships, Odesur Games, Pan Am Youth Championships The other events are generally single events, but there is the option, by the host (during the bidding stage) to indicate the interest to host a joint event
