

<u>Terms of Reference</u> <u>PAHF Appointments Panel</u>

0. DEFINITIONS

'Tournament official' shall include, but not be limited to:

- Technical Delegate
- Assistant Technical Delegate
- Technical Officials
- Medical Officer
- Communications Officer
- Umpire Manager
- Assistant Umpire Manager
- Umpire

1. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The overall aims and objectives of the Appointments Panel are to assist the PAHF in the following ways in relation to all hockey formats; outdoors, indoor, Hockey 5s and Beach Hockey:

- 1.1 To appoint officials for hockey tournaments, in all formats, as required by the FIH Regulations, PAHF Chart of Responsibility, Hosting Contracts with National Associations and/or the various PAHF policies and procedures based upon, but not limited to, the following criteria, as appropriate to the particular tournament:
 - Quality
 - Neutrality
 - Cost implications for host organizers
 - Development
 - Education
 - Set Panel appointment criteria and career path considerations
- 1.2 Ensure the correct application of the "Operational Procedure for the Nomination and Appointment of Technical Officials"

2. AUTHORITY, STRUCTURE AND MEMBERSHIP

- 2.1 The Panel derives its authority from the PAHF Board of Directors and adheres to the Panel protocols as approved by the PAHF Board of Directors.
- 2.2 Appointment Panel should have a Chair, and from 4-5 members, considering gender balance and a Secretary (PAHF staff-no vote).



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- 2.3 All members of the Panel must be retired International Tournament Officials and whenever possible the Panel composition will be representative of all North, South, Central America and Caribbean.
- 2.4 No member of the Panel shall be eligible for appointment at any tournament to which PAHF or the FIH appoints or approves technical officials.
- 2.5 The period of nomination on Appointment Panel is of two (2) years, so all members will be appointed on a biannual basis.
- 2.6 Appointments once made are final and only subject to the ratification or approval of FIH in case the tournament is a qualifier for a FIH competition.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES

3.1 FIH Events

Considerations or proposals of Officials for Pro League or World Level Events, whenever requested by FIH.

3.2 PAHF Events

- (i) Appointment of full Panel of Officials according to PAHF approved procedures.
- (ii) For tournaments which qualify teams for FIH World Level Events, appoint and seek approval of FIH for other technical officials (TD, UM and Neutral umpires are appointed by FIH).
- (iii) Approval of nominations of technical officials received from NAs for PAHF Tournaments, under criteria outlined on #1.1.

3.3 Invitational Tournaments

Appointment of technical officials in consultation with Competitions and Umpiring Panels. For additional details, please refer to the document titled "Process for PAHF sanction for an Event."

4. Confidentiality and Conflict of Interest

All members must abide and sign PAHF declaration of Confidentiality and Conflict of Interest.

5. The Appointment Panel has the authority from the Board of Directors to make final tournaments appointments following PAHF and FIH procedures and regulations. They may also adjust, amend and/or recommend changes to nominations proposals presented for their approval, the intention being to provide assistance to Committees and Advisory Panels with their appointment recommendation processes.
