<p>1. PAHF Rep: EB agreed in 2018 that Rep will no longer be appointed in future events. This decision may be reviewed.</p> <p>2. Pan Am Cups: This event is not normally a joint event due to the large hosting fee. 2 TD's or 1 TD &amp; 1 ATD may be appointed.</p> <p>3. ATD: This is optional. It can be used as an opportunity for development with specific Tier 1 joint events where there is 1 TD.</p> <p>4. MO: Local Medical Officer can be used. One PAHF doctor for the tournament.</p> <p>5. Media: Use more local personnel for coverage. The host is responsible for providing full board.</p> <p>6. AHF Umpire exchange: look to expand program with Europe for technical officials and umpires.</p> <p>7. *South American Championship every 4 years as the ODESUR and Multi Sports Games criteria apply</p> <p>8.**PAHF Event: Airfare, meals &amp; accommodation / Per Diem for all Officials and AHF / AfHF Exchange officials are paid for by the OC. If 2 neutral umpires are appointed along with AHF umpires, airfare for the additional umpire is paid for by AHF.</p> <p><b>The Event Coordinator ticket and accommodation paid for by PAHF. Meals / Per Diem by OC.</b></p> <p>9. ***For Multi Sports Events Airfare, accommodation, meals and per diem for all officials, including AHF exchange officials are paid by OC if only 1 neutral per gender (umpire &amp; TO) is appointed. If 2 neutral umpires are appointed with umpires from AHF, Tickets are by AHF or PAHF.</p> <p>Medical - 1 (PAHF pays ticket for appointed MO. Accommodation, meals/ Per Diem by OC. Local doctor working at the pitch does not need accommodation.</p> <p>1 Communication Officer ticket paid for by PAHF. Accommodation, meals/ Per Diem by OC.</p> <p>10. If PAHF hosts any Umpire, Coaching or Technical courses: The host is responsible for the accommodation and meals cost for the facilitators. PAHF is responsible for the airfare and honorarium for the facilitators.</p> <p>11. The number of teams for Tier 2 events are unlimited, as these events are usually qualifiers for Tier I events.</p> <p>12. At Tier 2 events for two (2) UMs are appointed of which one of the UMs will in a training capacity</p> <p>13. For the Pan Am Youth Championships, which is a hockey 5 event, the number of officials will be reviewed pending the number of teams registered</p> <p>14. <b>Tickets:</b> For all PAHF Events OC is responsible for the airfare of TD(s), UM(s) and Neutral Umpires.</p> <p>15. <b>Accommodation and Meals/ Per Diem:</b> OC is responsible for the accommodation and meals/ Per Diem for all officials.</p> <p>16. For the Tier 2 events, if there is an increase in the number of participating teams, then the increase in number of technical officials will be considered to ensure adequate coverage for the event.</p> <p>17. If the AHF is unable to appoint umpire(s) that is / are appropriate for the level of the tournament, PAHF will be advised to appoint two neutral umpires capable of officiating at the level of the event</p> <p>18. If the AHF is unable to appoint technical official(s) that is / are appropriate for the level of the tournament, the PAHF Appointments Committee can, at its discretion, appoint a PAHF technical official capable of officiating at the level of the event</p> <p>19. The AHF Exchange Program can invoked for either Tier 1 or Tier 2 Events, at the discretion of the PAHF Appointments Committee</p>						
<b>Event</b>						
If a "Joint or Single" event noted above is hosted as a single event, then 1/2 the number of Technical Officials (i.e. TO's & Umpires) applies.						
<b>Building Capacity</b>						
The use of "Officials from the Host" is an option available to the Appointments Committee in appointing officials. It is not an obligation under the Chart of Responsibility						
With more emphasis being placed on host nations to provide resources for medical and communication, templates and protocols for standard best practices are to be developed, so that the selected national officials are aware of the guidelines of their posts.						
For the local Communication Officer, generic assets or toolkits are to be developed as guidelines for them. Some possible training components should also be developed for these potential communication personnel, so that the pool can widen						
<b>Hosting</b>						
Mandatory joint events: Pan Am Games, Indoor Pan Am Championships, South American Championships, ODESUR Games, Pan Am Youth Championships The other events are generally single events, but there is the option, by the host (during the bidding stage) to indicate the interest to host a joint event						
<b>Fees</b>						
All Tournament Fees and deposits to be paid in advance to PAHF						
<b>Deposit</b>						
Deposits will be refunded on Team's full participation in Tournament
