Suspension of Manager of Dominica Republic

On July 22, 2010 I warned the manager of the Dominican Republic by letter that the under garments used by the ladies team in their game against Mexico was in contradiction of the instructions given at the Manager Briefing Meeting and hence constituted a breach of the Level 1 code of conduct.

Subsequently, in the game Dominican Republic against Puerto Rico played on July 24, 2010, eight players of the team were again in contravention of the code.

A level 2 breach was then brought against the manager for a recurrence of the Level 1 breach

The following decision was taken

That the manager of the Dominican Republic Women's team be suspended for 2 games.
