After the match, the TO on duty informed a breach of the Code of Conduct and presented a report in writing.

Code of Conduct:

4. Jurisdiction

(iii) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the following shall be regarded as conduct which is improper, unfair, and unacceptable:

- Throwing a stick or ball at or near a player, umpire or official in an inappropriate and/or dangerous manner.

Based on my review of the findings and considering the evidence, the TD's decision is as follows:

It is a Level 1 offense for the player #15 of Chile, Daniela Caram, who receives an official reprimand. Should the player repeat the offense again, it will be considered as a Level 2 offense (recurrent breach of Level 1 behavior) which requires a minimum of two (2) match suspensions.
