After the match, the TO on duty informed a breach of the Code of Conduct and presented a report in writing.

Code of Conduct:

4. Jurisdiction

(iii) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the following shall be regarded as conduct which is improper, unfair, and unacceptable:

(a) Verbal/physical abuse or hostility towards any other participant, person or any other member of the public.

(b) Disputing, protesting and/or reacting in a provocative or disapproving manner in an inappropriate way toward any decision made by an umpire or official.

Based on my review of the findings and considering the evidence, the TD's decision is as follows:

It is a Level 1 offense for the coach of Chile, Diego Amoroso, who receives an official reprimand. Should the coach repeat the offense again, it will be considered as a Level 2 offense (recurrent breach of Level 1 behavior) which requires a minimum of two (2) match suspensions.
