



Tournament Director's Decision

Breach of FIH Code of Conduct

Match – 1: Trinidad and Tobago v Dominican Republic (M)
Date: Saturday, November 15th, 2014
Player: No. 18 Mickell Pierre

Decision: Player No. 18 Mickell Pierre is found to have violated the following Rules and Directives of the FIH Code of Conduct.

- physical assault, without serious injury, of another player.

Mr. Pierre accepted the breach and maintained a very remorseful attitude throughout the deliberation. It is unknown to me of this player being involved in any similar infractions throughout his international career.

The game was very competitive and tempers flared at things, resulting in the umpires carding players from both teams in an effort to maintain control. In this particular incident, Mr. Pierre was not involved in the initial melee, but charged from his position and robustly and physically assaulted the opposing player with his hands.

After careful consideration of the evidence and the submissions of the player and his representative, my decision is as follows:

1. PIERRE Mickell (No. 18) of Trinidad and Tobago is suspended for two matches.
2. The suspension will be for the following matches:
 - TTO v CUB November 18th, 2014
 - TTO v GUA November 20th, 2014
