

Tournament Director's Decision Breach of FIH Code of Conduct

Match – 15 URU v CHI (W)

Date Saturday 15th March 2014

Player No. 13 COATES Mercedes

Decision

Player No. 13 COATES Mercedes is found to have violated the following Rules and Directives of the FIH Code of Conduct.

- Participants shall at all times conduct themselves fairly, properly and in an acceptable manner on the field of play and any part of the hockey venue/accommodation.
- No person may conduct themselves in a manner or commit any act or omission which may prejudice the interest of hockey or which may bring the game of hockey into disrepute.
- Physical assault, without serious injury, of another player, umpire, official or spectator

It is my opinion that this is a Level 2 offence because there was physical assault, without injury of another player.

Due to all the facts and findings, my decision is as follows:

- 1. COATES Mercedes (No. 13) of Uruguay is suspended for two matches.
- 2. The suspension will begin from March 16th 2014.
- 3. It will be Match 17 and the first match of the next international tournament that she is eligible to take part in.
