**Charge**: The *Level 1 was "*Level 1 2.2f: *Inappropriate or reckless physical contact between players in the course of play" towards Mexican Player No. 13 An Juarez* in Match #18: Cuba vs Mexico played on Tuesday 6th August 2019.

## Evidence produced:

- 1. Video sequences which showed the play in real time and in slow motion.
- 2. The Match Injury report from Match #18 Cuba vs Mexico which indicates that the umpires had to stop time due to an injury to Mexican Player No. 13 Ana Juarez.

## Disciplinary History of Player: None

Attitude of Player: Good. During the hearing, Ms. Roseli Harrys Ford accepted the charge. She explained her action in the situation, however she recognised now that her actions were wrong and she apologised for it.

**Decision**: Breach of the Code of Conduct Level 1 2.2f: Inappropriate or reckless physical contact between players in the course of play.

Having reviewed the video evidence, the demeanour of **Ms.** Roseli Harrys Ford at the hearing, taking into consideration all the evidence available and the fact that **Ms.** Roseli Harrys Ford has no recorded disciplinary history, the decision of the Technical Delegate is as follows:

- 1. Official Reprimand to Cuba No. 6 Roseli Harrys Ford.
- 2. Number of Matches suspended 0
