Warmup: Welcome back to London Canada for the 2nd Pan American Cup for Men

Warmup: This is Hari Kant here providing you live commentary.

Warmup: Three lopsided scores set the tone in the three Pool A games this morning.

Warmup: Argentina, Chile and the USA at the top of Pool B Rankings.

Warmup: Now we start with Pool B this afternoon

Warmup: Canada a perennial power in Americas Hockey

Warmup: Not having finished below 2nd in the past 20 years.

Warmup: They have had some close battles against T&T recently including a 3-2 win in last years Pan-American Games.

Warmup: The teams are warming up now while the sprinklers are watering the field

Warmup: It's a beautiful sunny afternoon here with a generous breeze to keep things cool.

Warmup: We'll be back with the push back at 4!

Warmup: We are almost ready to go

Warmup: The Canadian Team members are all wearing black armbands with the initials RR on them.

Warmup: This is to commemorate the recent passing of Ross Rutledge.

Warmup: Ross passed away last month in his prime

0: Ross played in two Olympics for Canada in the 80's and had a large influence in junior development in Canada following his retirement

- 1: We are underway
- 2: TRI with some early pressure and they have posession in the Canadian 25
- 2: Defended well and CAN clears.
- 3: This game looks a little more evenly contested than the morning matches.
- 5: TRI will look to their Captain Kwan Browne for leadership
- 5: Here is an attack by Canada
- 5: Shot by Sandison
- 6: Saved by Francis in the TRI goal
- 7: Now TRI moving towards the circle
- 7: A high pass and CAN counters.
- 8: TRI get it back but fail to earn a corner
- 10: Now a corner for CAN
- 10: They fail to get a shot off.
- 13: TRI with a cross into the circle
- 13: CAN defends and clear
- 15: TRI attack up the left
- 16: And a shot on goal from a small angle
- 16: Saved and the rebound saved again.

- 16: CAN caught on a long scoop but no harm caused
- 16: GARCIA for TRI got in behind
- 19: CAN Wettlaufer with a chance for a shot in the circle, but he cannot connect
- 20: TRI defending well by bunching up on the CAN ball carrier
- 20: But now Lee earns a corner for Canada
- 21: Drag Flick off the crossbar
- 21: And the Goalkeeper clears with his Glove
- 21: PS for CAN
- 22: The umpire deems that he batted the ball intentionally
- 22: GOAL: Rob Short scores on FRANCIS low stick side
- 25: Canada continues to pressure and are getting some circle penetrations.
- 25: TRI not able to move up the field to contain CAN when they clear
- 26: Now TRI with a long corner
- 30: CAN gains the circle but NORIEGA defends well and steals the pass
- 30: GOAL
- 30: A pretty goal by Canada. Campbell drives the circle and flips it past the keeper.
- 30: Grimes there to bat it in.
- 31: TRI counters but the umpire calls it against them in the CAN circle
- 32: The fans are not happy with that.
- 33: A scoop by Deol
- 33: And Grimes gets a shot that goes wide
- 35: TRI have managed to get some attack in this half, but have only generated 2-3 weak shots at goal.
- 35: CAN have kept them wide
- HT: That's the half
- HT: Canada should be happy with their start.
- HT: A two goal lead and other quality chances.
- HT: TRI played a reasonable half and had a good share of the posession.
- HT: However they didn't generate quality chances.
- 36: Second half underway
- 36: Canad right onto the attack and they have earned a corner.
- 36: Drag Flick by Fernandes wide.
- 39: TRI with a corner now.
- 40: It is broken but they earn another corner
- 40: Browne shoots wide
- 41: GOAL: Short for Canada
- 41: He tried to cross it but it went in off the stick of the defender and went it
- 42: Browne attacking back for TRI and they earn a corner
- 44: That is shot wide
- 44: Two corners for TRI that have gone wide.
- 44: CAN with a corner on the counter
- 44: That is hit and saved by FRANCIS
- 50: CAN with another Corner now
- 51: Hit by Kalhon is saved by FRANCIS
- 51: Nice save
- 52: TRI now attacking up their Left

 52: and some nice moves earn them a corner

 52: Drag flick by Browne is saved by Mahood

 53: TRI right back on the long corner and they earn another corner

 55: They don't get a shot off

 55: Now the pace of play has slowed considerably.

 56: But CAN continues to apply the pressure

 60: Some great play by GARCIA to earn a weak shot on goal.
- 60: Easilly saved by Mahood
- 60: Canada with a fast break, but the pass is off 60: It's back and forth now.
- 60: TRI with a free hit on the circles edge
- 60: Up comes Noriega to hit it
- 60: Defended well by CAN
- 64: TRI still attacking.
- 64: They are into the circle but Wettlaufer clears
- 66: CAN into the circle byt GORDON defends well for TRI
- 70: TRI with good chances
- 70: Two quality saves by Mahood
- 70: Canada backing off on defence and it's giving TRI some chances
- 70: Score remains 3-0
- 70: And in the last minute now
- Final: And that's it
- Final: A solid victory for Canada
- Final: With two goals in the first half and one insurance in the 2nd
- Final: Good saves by Mahood and some poor execution on PCs team kept the matter out of reach for Trinidad
- Final: TRI will be dissapointed having kept Canada close in their most recent encounters.
- Final: They will need to convert more of their chance to move ahead in ranking.
- Final: Canada to the top of Pool A.
- Final: The next scheduled game is Cuba vs Uruguay but as of this point Cuba has not arrived in London
- Final: There has been talk of rescheduling that match
- Final: For now this is Hari Kant signing off from London Canada. Thanks from PlanetFieldHockey and the Pan American Hockey
