Warmup: So we move on to Mexico and the Dutch Antilles. Warmup: The Dutch Antilles will be represented by AHO for their three letter country code. Warmup: We are almost ready to start the match. Warmup: National Anthems 0: And here we go. 0: Mexico in Green. 0: AHO in Blue 0: Mexico take the pushback and are controlling it around the back 1: The AHO players show their Dutch ancestry. 1: All tall lanky men 1: Mexico still controlling 2: And they earn their first corner 2: An early test for the AHO defence 2: Deflection saved by the AHO keeper and the rebound is high over the goal 4: Mexico continue to put pressure. 4: AHO defend well and clear the ball out. 7: Now the ball is in the midfield 7: Both teams using the scoop 8: A good chance for AHO but they cannot earn a corner 8: And here is a two on one 8: The pass is made and the shot is wide 8: Great field chances for the Dutch Antilles. 8: Mexico cannot take this team for granted. 10: AHO controlling the play for the past 5 minutes 11: They are moving the ball well and now earn a PC 11: Their first of the game

- 11: The drag flick is saved
- 12: And MEX clear it down the field
- 12: But they cannot control it
- 12: MEX is able to control the ball in the back but lose it quickly when attacking.
- 14: AHO stopping all the MEX attacks and then countering smartly down the wings.

18: Now MEX regaining some control in the midfield.
22: Nice attack but that is saved by the AHO keeper
22: This is become a slow midfield game after some early excitement
25: MEX now with the ball in the AHO 25
25: A foul outside the circle has earned them a corner.
25: Their second of the half
26: The sweep hit is saved by AHO #5 and he clears long.
27: A fast break and good defence from MEX prevents a clean break.
31: MEX with a chance from a free hit outside the circle.
31: That goes into the goal without being touched by the diving forward
31: All MEX now in the last 5 minutes
31: They would like to get a goal before the half
31: But here comes AHO
31: MEX defending in numbers
32: But that means a lot of shoes to hit and that's what AHO does.
32: PC for the Dutch Antilles
33: The hit is deflected over the goal
33: What a great chance and the AHO player puts it over the net
35: Now in the midfield
35: And that's the end of the first half
HT: An even half
HT: I think MEX was surprized at the quality of the AHO defending
HT: And the swift manner in which they attack
37: AHO with possession up the right hand side
37: In the circle and a nice save by the MEX GK
37: AHO continue to pressure but they lose it off the endline
38: MEX try to run it out of defence but that doesn't work
40: AHO is continuing to frustrate MEX
41: AHO with the ball in the MEX half and now MEX gets a green card
41: Now a nice move into the circle and AHO earns a PC
41: GOAL!!!!
42: The Netherlands Antilles takes the lead
42: A drag flick to the top stick side
42: Great goal and the crowd is enjoying it.
43: The AHO team showed great spirit during the opening ceremonies and now the crowd returning the cheers
43: MEX struggling to get the ball out of their half
43: AHO controlling in the offensive end.
45: A great attacking run by AHO 16.
45: His shot is just wide but his teammate was there for the deflection
46: MEX just losing the ball too easilly here.
48: A great run by AHO and a desperate save by the MEX defender keeps the score at 1-0
49: Another long run by AHO and there is a loose ball foul and the umpire awards a PC
49: AHO scored on their last PC with a flick
50: GOAL: This time to the glove side high!
50: That is for sure in the Dutch style.

51: There is a lot of room in teh MEX defence for these long runs
51: But MEX cannot get posession outside of the 25
51: The sun has finally set here and it has gotten chiily
54: MEX now attacking well
55: A chance outside the circle, but a bad pass puts an end to that
55: AHO lose the ball and MEX
55: counters and earns a corner.
55: MEX need this goal to get back into the game
55: They try a layoff but AHO counters
56: They are in the circle but cannot control the ball
56: MEX in their half
57: The game is a getting rough
57: There have been two green cards and now two more
57: MEX playing desperate and trying to barge their way into the circle
59: Now MEX attackes with a scoop
60: THey break to the circle but the pass is out of reach
60: AHO clears
62: And they get a great chance but the MEX keeper steps up and kicks it out
62: MEX moving forward and a bad tackle outside of the 25 earns them a PC
63: The Option hits his own player and AHO try to move it up
64: Some good play in the MEX end
64: MEX does well to clear under the pressure
65: But with the score 2-0 they are running out of time
67: AHO not giving the MEX players any room to dribble.
68: Now MEX with a chance at the edge of the circle.
68: Saved and cleared by AHO
68: MEX regains control but put if off the endline.
68: 2 minutes to play
69: MEX still trying to get a goal
69: But AHO holds
69: Now they attack up the right
69: Free hit outside the circle
69: MEX cannot clear
70: They do and now move up the field
70: A cross D scoop to an open winger but he cannot control
70: And AHO on a fast break but the MEX keeper comes out to save that
70: The final Horn
Final: The Dutch Antilles have won their opening match of the Pan American Cup
Final: Mexico flew in late last night and may have underestimated this oposition
Final: AHO enjoying their warm down laps
Final: MEX could not move the ball fowards as the Dutch ANtilles players cut off the passing lanes and channeled well
Final: AHO had some field opportunities but those were handled well by the MEX keeper.
Final: Where they capitalized was on the Drag Flick Penalty Corners.
Final: That's a story we've heard before.
Final: So AHO moves to 2nd spot in Pool B, just one goal behind Canada
